DESCRIPTION OF THE ACTIVITIES

M and M Workshops is time for music and movement!

Warming up playing games with singing and body percussion. With these games our aim is to develop the voice, as well as rhythmic and auditory skills.

Dance Learn choreographies to popular songs, promoting expression and communication through rhythm and movement.

Musical hearing games and introduction to classical instruments. Participate in games that enhance active listening skills and get introduced to classical instruments.

Playing instruments introduction to the piano and percussion instruments, e.g. African drums, shakers, xylophones and small percussion. Learn basic rhythms and sounds through games, improvisation, and creating new pieces.

BUILDING INSTRUMENTS AND MUSIC MATERIAL!

Children will have the opportunity to build instruments like maracas, kazoos, drums, guitars, castanets, and puppets.

CHAMBER MUSIC, COMPOSING AND IMPROVISATION TEAM WORK!

Collaboratively develop, create, and improvise music pieces to play together. If your child has their own instrument, they are welcome to bring it!

THEATER, PUPPETS AND CINEMA MUSIC

Create and perform music for a film, as well as participate in music and puppet theater using percussion, voice, melodic instruments, and instruments crafted during the camp.

WORLD MUSIC AND CONTEMPORARY MUSIC WORKSHOPS

Embark on a musical journey exploring diverse folklores from India to Africa and engage in contemporary music.
